

2012 Louisiana Referee Recertification

Note: Referees that were NOT registered in 2011 but were registered in either 2009 or 2010 must complete an application form and wait for account information before proceeding with the steps below.

For referees that are registered in 2011, these are the steps for completion of the 2012 recertification process (in this order):

1. ALL REFEREES (as well as assignors, assessors, and instructors), regardless of grade, must complete the LSA Risk Management Disclosure Process. You should have received or will receive login and password information from the support@gotsoccer.com address. Please search both your inbox and junk mail folders. If you have completed Risk Management after July 1st in another capacity (coach, manager, etc.), please log in with your referee credentials and "match" your existing report to your referee account. Once you get your login/password information from GotSoccer, please login to GotSoccer and submit a Risk Management disclosure.

2. Grade 8 and grade 9 referees must take an online recertification test. For all tests, you will need your 16-digit USSF Referee ID.

- Grade 9 referees: take the 2012 Grade 9 Recertification Test. Password is yellowcard.
- Grade 8 referees: take the 2012 Grade 8 Recertification Test. Password is redcard.
- Arbitros Grado 8: tomar el Examen de Recertificación Grado 8 2012. Código es redcard.

3. Register with the US SOCCER Federation. This step can be completed online. Your user id is R followed by your 16-digit USSF ID. Password is your last name, unless previously changed.
